## INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE COLLECTION OF SEMEN SPECIMENS FOR MALE FERTILITY STUDIES

In order to properly assess fertility, it is important that a semen specimen be obtained and transported in a manner that will produce accurate results. Compliance with the following instructions will help ensure a high quality specimen that will provide accurate information for your healthcare provider.

- Prior to collection: <u>Refrain from sexual activity</u>, including masturbation, <u>for 48 to 72 hours prior</u> to collecting specimen. Periods of less than 48 hours may result in decreased sperm concentrations. Intervals that exceed 7 days result in increased sperm concentrations with a decrease in motile and viable forms. Do not use lubricants as they can kill sperm cells. Avoid oral and vaginal secretions which will contaminate the specimen.
- Before collecting the specimen: <u>call</u> the St Joseph Hospital Laboratory <u>to schedule</u> the collection drop off. We accept semen specimens between 7 am and 11 am, Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursday ONLY. Specimens cannot be accepted on Fridays, weekends or holidays. <u>Call 882-3000</u>, <u>ext 67215</u> between 7am and 5pm to schedule a collection. <u>Sterile containers and labels may be obtained at the St Joseph Hospital Laboratory or from your medical provider's office</u>.
- Collection Instructions: Semen samples are best obtained by masturbation directly into a sterile container. Other forms of collection, such as interrupted intercourse, are discouraged because it increases the possibility of an incomplete or contaminated collection. <u>DO NOT submit specimens in a condom</u>. Care must be taken to <u>include the entire specimen</u>. Loss of the first portion of the ejaculate may result in inaccurate test results.
  - a. Wash hands and rinse thoroughly so all soap is rinsed away.
  - b. Open sterile container. Do not touch inside of container.
  - c. Masturbate to ejaculation and deposit <u>all</u> your semen into the container.
  - d. Replace the cover on the container and tighten securely. Keep container upright.
  - e. Label the container with the patient's full name, date of birth, date and time specimen collected. We cannot accept unlabeled or incompletely labeled specimens.
- 4. Bring the specimen to the laboratory within 1 hour of collection and maintain it at body temperature during transport. This can be accomplished by placing the container into a bag then into an inside pocket of the clothing, close to your body. Do not expose samples to extreme heat or cold.
- 5. Complete the following information at the time you bring the specimen to our lab:
